\$25.00 per member

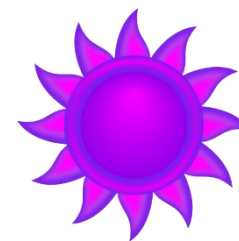
Children must be signed up as a “member”

IMPORTANT: LATE POLICY

4:31-\$10 additional charge per member (TOTAL: \$35)

5:00 p.m. - \$15.00 additional charge per member (TOTAL: \$50)

All late fees must be paid by the Friday of the same week the lateness occurred; if lateness occurred on a Friday, please pay the fee by the Monday morning of the following week. Failure to pay will result in your child not able to participate in an additional week of camp. Please note: After 5:00 p.m., our staff will contact the Worcester Police Department for assistance.

Specialty Programs

In addition to the regular summer program, we also provide the following opportunities:

Swim Clinic

An athletic program (8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.) designed for those interested in joining the Club's swim team in the fall. Group swim lessons will be provided. Participants must bring appropriate gear that is labeled (towel, goggles, and change of clothes) and be ready for workouts.

G.A.N.G. Camp

In partnership with the Worcester Police Gang Unit, this program provides kids with social recreation opportunities while they also learn about gang prevention and the importance of a healthy lifestyle. All registered participants will participate in one week of G.A.N.G. Camp.

SMARTGirls

Designed for girls ages 10 – 14 years old, this program addresses topics like self-esteem & body image, peer relationships, dating violence and conflict resolution in a supportive and fun environment.

Co-Ed Drama

A seven-week theatre program for kids who want to learn about set design, costuming, playwriting, and acting. Participants in this program are asked to participate four out of the five days per week for all seven weeks.
