**Week C2**, Week 7– Welcome to our College & Career Week! During this informative week, participants will go on college tours, participate in job shadowing, take part in resume-writing workshops, and be offered the opportunity to partake in certification programs such as ServSafe and lifeguard certifications. 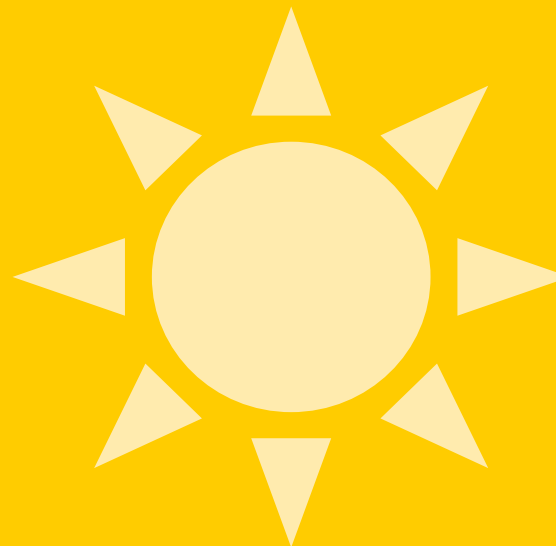

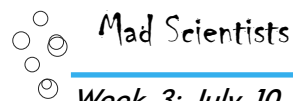

## Specialty Programs



In addition to the regular summer programs, we also provide the following opportunities:

### Swim Clinic

An athletic program (8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m.) designed for those interested in joining the Club's swim team in the fall. Group swim lessons will be provided. Participants must bring appropriate gear that is labeled (towel, goggles, and change of clothes) and be ready for workouts.

### G.A.N.G. Camp
