

### Swimming Pool \$5,000,000

Our new swimming pool will be the first in Great Brook Valley, providing life-saving water safety instruction to thousands of youth each year. It will also host “Mommy & Me” and adult swim lessons to help break generational barriers to swimming. Studies show that when parents don’t know how to swim, their children are far less likely to learn, making these programs essential for community-wide safety and confidence. (7,170 sq. ft.)



### Kid's Café & Teaching Kitchen \$4,000,000

Did you know that in Worcester, one in four children go to bed hungry each night? Our Kid's Café will serve nutritious dinners to more than 500 youth daily, ensuring they have the fuel to learn, grow, and thrive. Our teaching kitchen will also play a key role in our Workforce Development program, offering teens hands-on culinary training led by industry professionals and the opportunity to earn ServSafe certification. (4,696 sq. ft.)



### Teen/Workforce Development Center \$3,000,000

Our Teen/Workforce Development Center will provide thousands of North Worcester teens with access to job training, certifications, Driver's Education, and college preparation resources. The space will also serve the broader North Worcester community during non-Club hours, offering adults in Great Brook Valley opportunities for workforce training and career advancement. **Gymnasium**

\$7,500,000

*The hub of our Healthy Habits program, the gymnasium will host various athletic games, tournaments, leagues, and recreational programming. (10,271 sq. ft.)*

*Our Arts Center will include areas for studio/digital arts, drama, dance, and music, providing a safe space to youth who express themselves through these life-saving outlets. (1,70 sq. ft.)*


**Academic Center**


2 out of 3 kids who participate in our Healthy Habits curriculum state they exercise at least once a day and are more likely to eat more vegetables.

**7 Games/Hangout Area**

\$1,000,000

Often referred to as gateway room, our games room will be an inviting space with various activities for all youth who walk through our doors. (1,677 sq. ft.)

**8 Food Pantry**

\$1,000,000

Stocked with non-perishable foods, meats, dairy, hygienic supplies, and household cleaning products all free of charge, our community food pantry will be designed to emulate a grocery store to provide the community with a dignified shopping experience. (1,584 sq. ft.)

**9 Clothing Pantry**

\$500,000

Similar in concept to our food pantry, our clothing pantry will look like a real clothing store, where our teens can shop and also gain essential retail experience working the registers and merchandising. (879 sq. ft.)

**10 Lobby**

\$500,000

As the first room guests see when entering our new facility, the lobby will host our reception area and will feature the beginning of our community mural. (714 sq. ft.)

**11 Administrative Suite**

\$50,000

Our Administrative Suite includes two staff offices and an administrative office. (1,019 sq. ft.)


**12 Staff Office (two available)**
